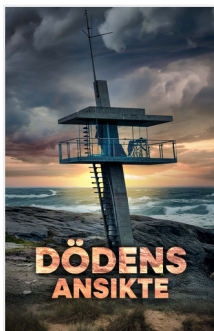

Andreas tries to stay out of the police investigation. He is busy with his work at the hospital and life with Stina and the children, and after a turbulent time, life has finally begun to feel safe again.
